# Absentee Ballot Application

**Vote absentee in the upcoming election

If you already submitted an absentee ballot request for the 2014 primary election or all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections, there is no need to submit another request. Please disregard this mailing.

The Primary Election is August 26, 2014.

## Florida Absentee Ballot Application

One application shall be deemed sufficient to receive an absentee ballot for all elections through the next regularly scheduled general election. To be processed for the next election, the application must be received by the Supervisor of Elections by 5pm on the 6<sup>th</sup> day before an election. If you are a **first-time** Florida voter who registered **by mail**, and you did **not** include your Florida driver's license number or Florida identification card number on your voter registration form, then you must provide a copy of your identification with this application or with your ballot or indicate that you are exempt from this requirement prior to voting. Acceptable forms of ID include: a copy of an unexpired photo ID that shows your name (U.S. passport, debit or credit card, military ID, Student ID, retirement center ID, neighborhood association ID, public assistance ID) OR a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document that shows your name and Florida address. The following persons are exempt from voter identification requirements provided by Florida law: persons older than 65, persons with a temporary or permanent physical disability, members of the uniformed service on active duty or members of the Merchant Marine who, because of duty, are absent from the county on election day, the spouse or dependent of an active duty uniformed service or Merchant Marine member who are absent from the county by reason of the active duty of the service member, and persons currently residing outside the county who are eligible to vote in Florida.
